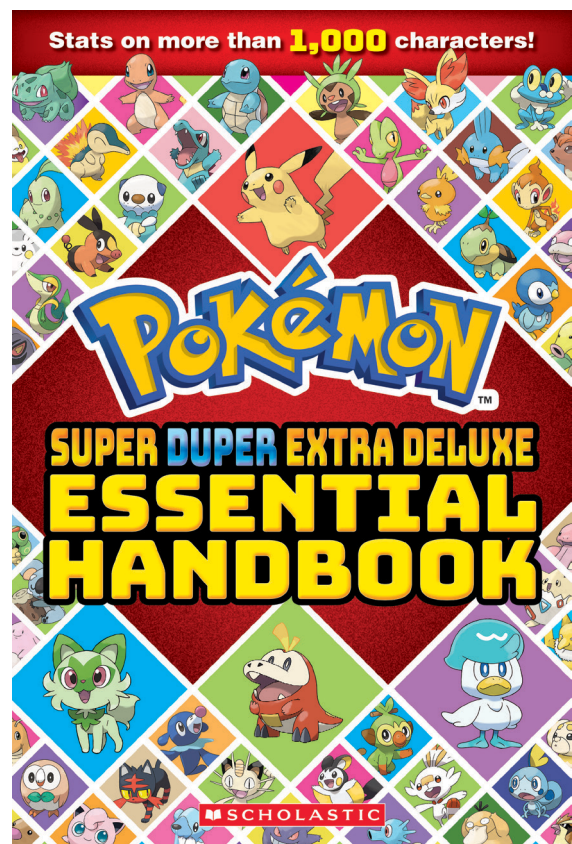

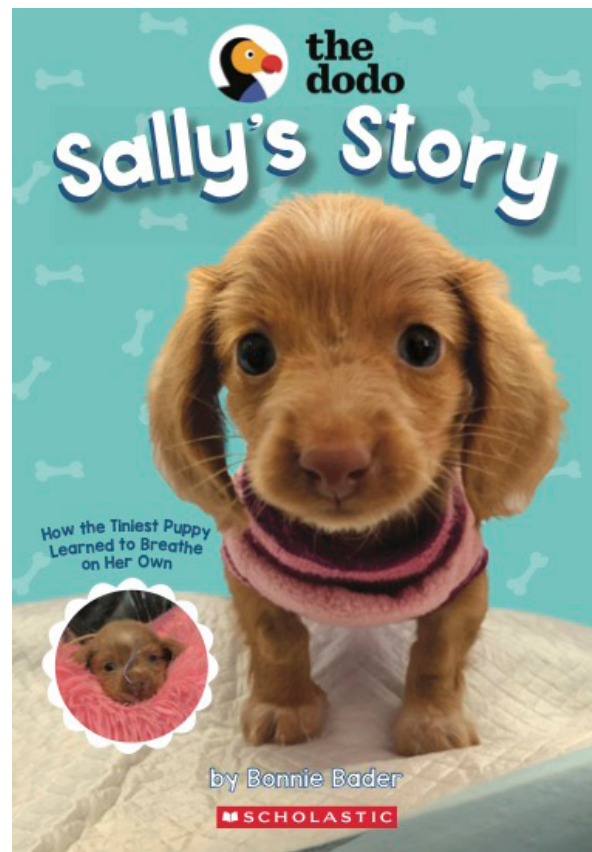
# THE DODO: SALLY'S STORY

# FGTEEV BLASTS OFF!

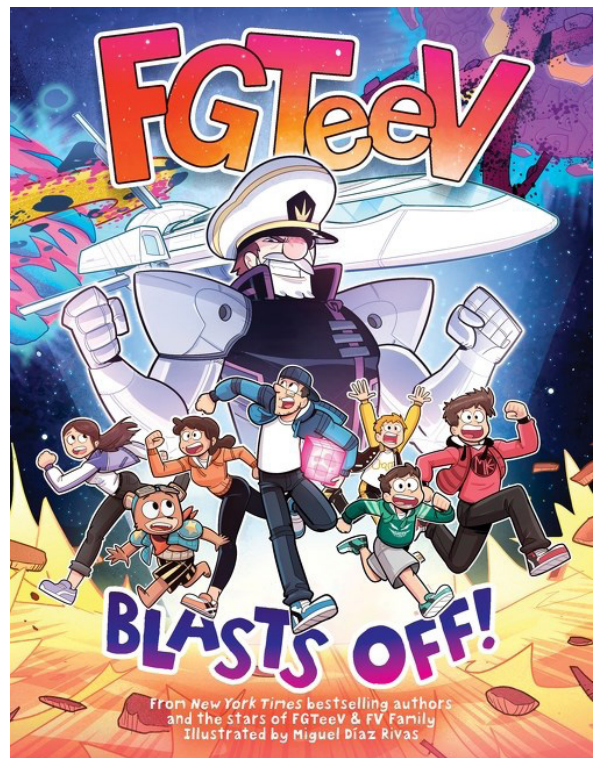

# DREAD DETENTION

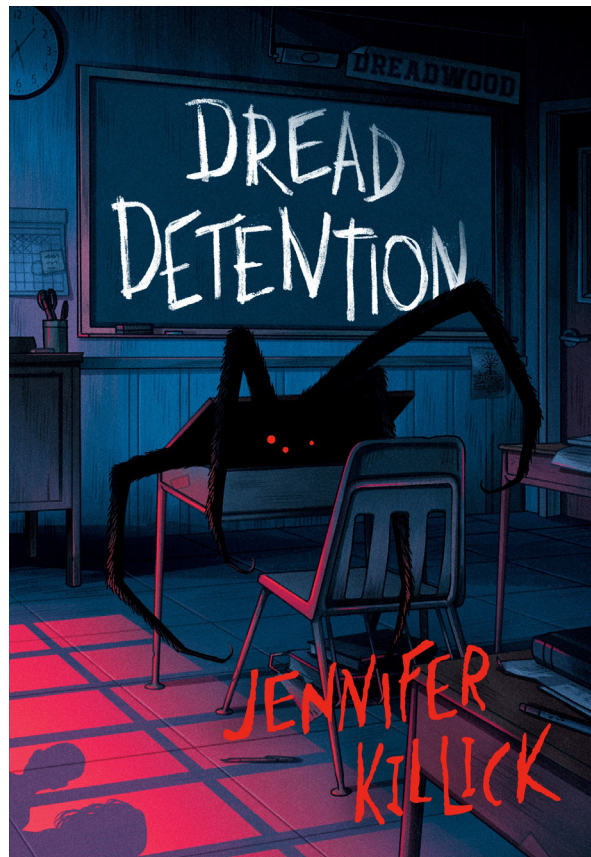

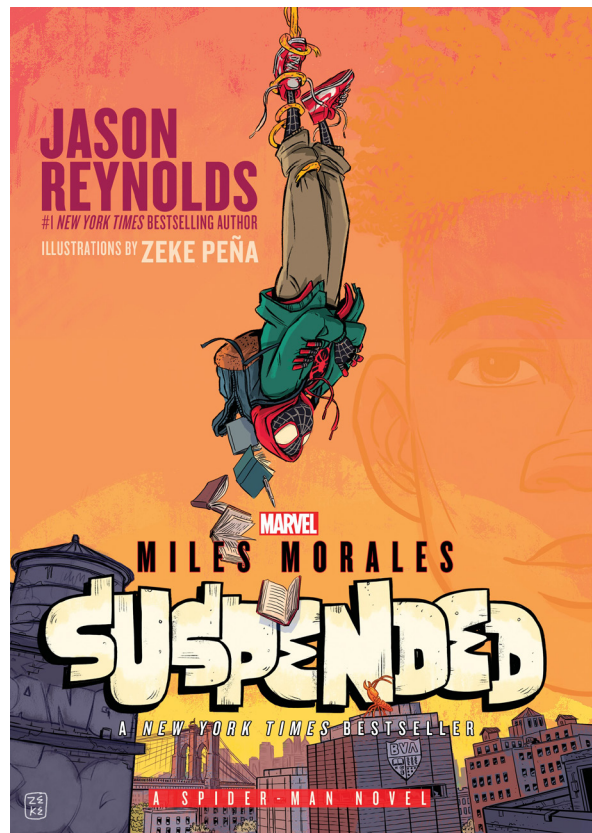
# MILES MORALES SUSPENDED: A SPIDER-MAN NOVEL
